Who can be a Junior Achievement Scholarship Recipient?

Requirements are:

- **Participated in Junior Achievement program, at least once, in your school career.**
- Students must plan to attend an accredited college, trade school, training program, etc. within two years of being awarded.
- Complete all parts of the application, including the Student Information Form below and Essay

Essay:

Your essay should be 500-750 words max, type size 12, and double spaced. Essays are judged on both content and grammar. Please choose one of the following essay options:

- Describe how Junior Achievement's Pathways of financial literacy, work and career readiness and entrepreneurship have impacted your academic and personal development and how it will empower you to own your future success.
- Describe yourself as a person and/or student. Share an accomplishment you are proud of and/or a challenge you overcame. Share an example or story of how you exemplify being a JA student.

Essay submissions can be emailed to khyman@jawny.org by 5:00 pm on May 22, 2026 as a Word doc, or PDF. Please be sure to include student name and school at top of essay. Remember to complete the Student Information Form as well. Applications will not be considered complete without the essay and student info form.

Notes:

- Students that apply will be eligible for all scholarship.
- If selected as a scholarship recipient funds from the scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient's

college upon proof of enrollment (up to two years after award). Award will be forfeited if not claimed by the two year expiration date.

- Please remember to complete the Student Information form below in addition to your essay submission.

Students missing any part of their submissions - Student Info Form or Essay- will not be considered. Please be sure to complete both parts by the deadline. Essays can be submitted to Kara Hyman (khyman@jawnny.org) no later than May 22nd, 2026.

Applications will be reviewed shortly after the deadline and recipients will be notified in early June.
